- 5. For Hindi paper Kruti Dev 010 font size 14 & 15 spacing, the text and should follow Modern Language Association (MLA).
- 6. Submitted papers must not have previously published, submitted, accepted for publication under review.
- 7. Certificate will be awarded to all the registered participants/presenters who will submit abstract & full paper.
